Jean-François Bottollier-Depois studied physics at the Grenoble University. He prepared a PhD in nuclear physics, speciality instrumentation and measurements. He went to CERN as a Fellow for 3 years. Employed since 1992 at the Institute for Radiological Protection and Nuclear Safety (IRSN, France) in the field of Radiation Protection. He was the Head of external dosimetry department from 2003 to 2015 in charge of dosimetry research and expertise in various sectors of activity (industry, medicine, aeronautic...). Involved in dosimetric system R&D; dosimetric studies for workers, patients and public; and dose reconstruction in case of radiological accident.

Since 2016, he is Deputy Director of Radiological Protection and Health. Member of various organisations: ISO, ICRU, ICRP, EURADOS. He is currently the Chair of the ISO/TC85/SC2 in charge of providing standards for radiation protection.
